1. CPMEC Governance

July 1 - registered as not-for-profit company:

 - Liaison Heads: Accreditation; Workforce; Education & Training
- Advisory Council
- Principal Officers Committee
- ANZ JMO Forum Chairs Committee
- Medical Education Officers' Committee
- Directors of Clinical Training Committee



2. CPMEC Funding

Pre 2010/11

- Three year DoHA funding
- MTRP project funding (to June 2008)
 - ACF, PDPR, TotR, PMAF
- DoHA support for ACF in 2008/9 and 2009/10

2010/11

- One year DoHA funding encouraged to find other sources
 HWA? MTRP? jurisdictions? commercial? MBA? fees?
- No ACF funding unless/until ACF incorporated in NRAS
 - ACF development suspended

3. National Registration & Accreditation

- 2009: CPMEC Paper on Internship and NRAS
 - 47 weeks of accredited rotations
 - 8 to 10 weeks of med, surg and em med based on content not site
 - Workplace based assessment of ACF learning objectives from the ACF
 - Dual sign off for full registration
- MBA requested AMC advice on:
 - the standards for intern training;
 - what should be expected of interns to grant general registration; and
 - a national framework for intern accreditation
- AMC Working Party CPMEC representation
- PGY2?


Geoff Marel Medal
